Teachers' Pay Increase Wins OK In Willows

WILLOWS — A Willows Unified School District Teachers Association proposal that all certificated and classified personnel be given a 3.25 per cent salary increase...

When the proposal was submitted last month, the teachers' group asked that negotiations be delayed until after the school year has been approved by the school trustees.

The trustees approved the proposal last month, the teachers' group said. It indicated that the board hoped to move forward on the Willows salary schedule near the average of or above the 1972-73 school year.

The MTUA proposal included the expectation to seek another 3.25 per cent teacher salary increase in the spring for the 1973-74 school year.

The trustees pointed out that the 30 schools used for comparison were derived by an earlier board which preferred area schools for comparison purposes.

Weekly Paper Takes Most Of Woman Publisher's Time

GEORGETOWN, Md. (UPI) — Mrs. Arlene Eberhardt is publisher and editor of the Georgetown Citizen and Townsman, a job she has been doing since she left her husband and two sons at home in 1963.

Mrs. Eberhardt has willingly taken a job only a person truly in love with journalism can handle, that of handling almost every phase in the production of a small weekly newspaper.

This requires her to devote at least 60 hours a week to news gathering, writing, photographing, editing, advertising, page layout and delivery to the printing firm.

She has only two part-time employees and some local volunteers to help her, together, the 12-page weekly, which has a circulation of 1,100 papers.

When she purchased the paper 13 years ago, it consisted of four pages with only about 200 subscribers.

After spending a week with her family, she drove over 100 miles to Georgetown every Sunday to work on the paper.

One of only 30 women publishers among the 425 members of the California Newspaper Publishers Association, she started her journalism career in 1955 as a correspondent for a daily newspaper.

She began looking for a weekly newspaper in the area which she got for sale last fall.

Most of my problems arise from being a woman. If you, however, the community has accepted me as a woman publisher because I have proved a woman can do the job, she added.
