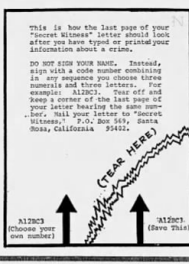
If your information results in the arrest and conviction of the slayer of either of the two girls above, call me and give your code number. A reward will be arranged and payment made. There will be no phone, register, no reporter, no publicity.

To refresh your memory, Lori Lee Karius's nude body was found along Highway 101. Her 16-year-old body was found along Highway 101. The Secret Witness program was started by the Press Democrat, San Rafael, at 4 p.m. March 31. It is a public-opinion survey of the general community where Lori Karius's body was found.

The Sacramento Bee reported the program is still active and in the first six months about 40,000 letters with three numerals in the first month of the program.
