Ex-Guard Guilty in Dump Bribes

A former watchman at the city's Southwest Philadelphia landfill pleaded guilty yesterday to bribery and conspiracy charges in connection with a kickback scheme that allegedly allowed a corporation to dump untreated wastes illegally.

Calvin Carson, 43, of Fernon St. near 23d, pleaded guilty before Common Pleas Judge David Klein to 20 counts of bribery and two counts of conspiracy. He was sentenced to 18-19 months in the Detention Center, but will be sentenced twice more until his sentence totals 2-5 years in prison.

IN EXCHANGE for Carson's cooperation in a continuing probe into illegal dumping at city landfills, the district attorney's office agreed to permit Carson to serve his full term in county, rather than state, prisons.

Eighteen to 19 months is the longest sentence that can be given to a county prisoner at one time.

Carson allegedly received more than \$21,000 from Franklin P. Tyson, former president of the now-bankrupt ABM Disposal Service Co., to dump industrial waste without city approval. Tyson is awaiting trial.



Judge Stalls Fla. Execution

A federal judge in Jacksonville, Fla., yesterday indefinitely stayed the execution of Charles W. Profitt, who was scheduled to die this morning in Florida's electric chair.

U.S. District Judge W. Terrell Hodges said he was assigning the case "for consideration and a... recommendation as to whether an evidentiary hearing or other appropriate proceeding will be necessary."

Robert Sullivan, who also was scheduled to die in Florida this morning, won a reprieve Monday.

that the children were dropped off with a baby-sitter. He said he knew of no arrangements for the children to be left with someone but "we're hoping."

The father was with Michael Friday night at a father-son softball game in Haverford. He told police that his ex-wife picked up the children after the game.

The news of Mrs. Reinert's murder

"stunned" her Main Line neighbors.

"SUE WAS the last one you'd think this would happen to," said a neighbor. "She was so cautious. She was careful about who she was with. That's the way it was."

The majority of the male friends who she had were met through PWP. "I can't imagine it (killer) was someone she didn't know," said another neighbor. "Her children were her social life. She didn't go out to bars. She called them a 'freak scene.'"

Not Running For Office, Tate Claims

"I have no aspirations for political office. I just want to be helpful. The Democratic Party has been very good to me and I'm paying off an obligation I think I owe it."

So explained the new finance chairman of the Democratic Committee of Atlantic County today by telephone from Longport, N.J. He is ex-Mayor of Philadelphia James H. J. Tate, now 69 and living in retirement at his former summer home in Longport.

TATE DESCRIBES his re-entrance into politics, announced Monday during a press conference at the Boardwalk Regency, as mainly advisory.

"The Democratic Committee here is very loosely organized. They don't have a budget. They don't have a headquarters. They don't even know who the Democrats are."

"You see, they have a strange law down here. There's no registration street list setup — you don't indicate your party till you go to vote at the primary. I suggested a program to find out who the Democrats are by having volunteer people go to the county election commission and get a list of the Democrats in each division. We really ought to have a broad-based appeal for funds."

Tate agreed to take the finance job at the suggestion of County Chairman Anna Marie Codario, a retired teacher engaged in commercial farming near Vineland.

"I WON'T GET involved in any strenuous activity," he says, "because I still have things to do in Philadelphia. I'm still a member of several boards and commissions."

Tate and his wife Ann made their permanent home in Longport as of the end of last March. Philadelphia's mayor from 1962 to 1972 plays golf "three or four times a week," feels fit and expresses the hope that "God will give me a few more good years."
