WASHINGTON (UPI) — The Food and Drug Administration has ordered a new look at cyclamate, a sweetener used in soft drinks. The agency said it will conduct a study to determine if cyclamate is safe for use as a sweetener. The study will be completed by the end of the year. Cyclamate is a sweetener that is 30 times sweeter than sugar. It is used in soft drinks, chewing gum, and other products. The FDA has received reports that cyclamate may be carcinogenic. The agency is conducting a study to determine if this is true.
