GARSTKA, OF Edgewater Park, N.J., testified that Gurel had blood on his shirt and was weeping when she met him, at his request, at the Cinna-minson Diner on Rte. 130 in New Jersey on Aug. 1. She said Gurel ordered her at gunpoint into a car she recognized as Sarika's, and threatened to kill her if is bried to carge.

Garstka said she ran to a nearby home, phoned police and led them to Sarika's home, where the bodies were found. Gurel surrendered to police four days later.
