Drivers Fear Random Bombings

ST. LOUIS (AP) — Three bombs that were triggered when motorists entered their cars have killed two people, raised fear among residents of southern St. Louis County and set police hunting for a mysterious suspect.

Harley Marie Pines, 35, a computer analyst, was killed Thursday when she started her compact car in the parking lot of the apartment complex where she lived.

Subsequent tests showed sticks of dynamite had been placed under the driver's seat and wired to the ignition.

The third bombing in a month — all within 10-

miles and apparently without motive — prompted police to increase patrols of the area.

A news conference was scheduled Friday to brief neighborhood residents on preventing themselves from being killed.

Authorities said they believed one person was responsible for Mrs. Pines' death and the two earlier explosions. They said the bomber had an extensive knowledge of electronics and electrical systems.

Harold Stangor, 35, an escaped arsonist, was arrested Wednesday when a bomb with similar explosives blew him off under his car

Orchestra Funds Enable Amtrak to Keep East Routes

CINCINNATI (AP) — The Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra is looking for a new music director after naming the aging Thomas Schippers the orchestra's first conductor for life.

Schippers, 67, director since 1975, missed most of last season and has not appeared with the company at all this season.

Schippers was criticized last winter — with, among other things, a vote of no confidence by the Memorial Union Orchestra's board of directors at the city's request.

City subsequently diagnosed him as senile.

Funds Enable Amtrak to Keep East Routes

WASHINGTON (AP) — With an \$8 million boost from Congress, Amtrak will retain a series of train routes in the Northeast Corridor that had been scheduled for termination last month.

Amtrak had asked for \$6.5 million to supplement congressional appropriations for fiscal 1978.

While immediate cuts in train service have been averted, Amtrak officials said Thursday that all routes would still remain under study to determine which can be eliminated or restricted.

With the additional funds, Amtrak also will be able to restore a few routes eliminated last January.
