Tree-planting will be council topic

Before deciding which kinds of trees to allow in Cape Coral, the city council must first vote tonight whether to allow trees near public streets, according to

Mayor Lyman Moore. He said a proposed ordinance, if approved, would allow residents to plant trees within 15 feet of a public roadway after receiving a permit from the city. A public hearing on what types of trees to allow is scheduled

immediately following the ordinance vote tonight. Council convenes at 7:30 p.m. Moore said that if the ordinance is not passed, the public won't have a chance to discuss the types of trees they want "because people won't be able to plant trees

near roads anyway." The proposed ordinance was presented by Councilwoman Arnie Koltzner. Moore said some council members may be worried that trees near streets will damage city sewer lines or impose traffic hazards.

Charlotte murder suspect sought

PORT CHARLOTTE — Sheriff's department investigators continue the hunt for a suspect in last week's abduction-killing of a 12-year-old Fort Charlotte girl. Firefighters discovered the charred body of Linda Ribicci in a burning field near Toledo Blade

Boulevard about midnight Thursday. Investigators will not say what leads, if any, they have at this point. Lt. Bill Clement said Sunday, "We are checking out everything we hear, good or bad. Even if we hear something that doesn't sound good, we'll be checking it out," Clement said.

Larven have gone door-to-door along the route the girl is believed to have taken from her home at 900 Albany Circle to a convenience store at Midway Boulevard and 12 S. Sheriff Alan Letreau said that anyone who might have seen anything, no matter how trivial, should contact the sheriff's office immediately.

Elderly Boca Grande man drowns

An elderly Boca Grande resident was pulled from the back bay of Gasparilla Island Sunday, the victim of an apparent drowning. A Lee County sheriff's agent said the man may have suffered a heart attack. The identity of the dead man was not released,

pending notification of relatives. Witnesses said sheriff's agents that they saw the man walking down a dock toward a boat, carrying a gunmetal can. Witnesses later found the man floating in the water. An autopsy will be conducted today to determine cause of death, officials said.
