home with machine-gun fire hours after the funeral of Sadat on Saturday. The report was only one of a series of scattered reports of violence in Cairo.

One report said at least two police stations had been attacked along the Sadat boulevard. Another said police officers had beaten Muslim extremists, hurled into a mosque, in a Cairo street area called Shari.

According to still another report, 300 to 350 military personnel, mostly officers, were rounded up in Cairo, although there was no indication that they might have been engaged in a violent act.

On the politically sensitive issue of how the United States should deal with the Palestinian issue, Ford said that at some point the United States will have to talk to the PLO, said a link that will help.

The former president, however, used general language of the Palestinian people as a single entity, with Ford suggesting that leaders of the PLO should be invited to the White House and with Carter cautioning that Palestinian political impasse may not always take the form of violence.

Philippines flood toll near 200

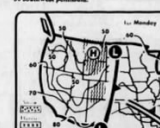
