Even though the majority of support in Southwest Florida is in a recall battle and already are under a quarantine, the law imposed Friday will have a significant impact on growers who are in the middle of developing land to plant an.

"If that quarantine lasts for any length of time, it could have a serious impact on growers in Collier county. After the freeze our citrus acreage was reduced dramatically, so we are now in the middle of a large expansion — I fear there are about 35,000 acres being developed in this county," Townsend said.

"If, after investing the money to get the land ready and set up irrigation and get the necessary permits, a person finds that the quarantine has been ordered, it's going to have a serious impact on their investment," he said.

Townsend said he received official word about the quarantine, but said state officials must have thought it was necessary or they would not have taken such drastic measures.

"I don't think they would have done this if they didn't think it was absolutely necessary to stop this spread in the land, so to speak, because that is going to have a very serious impact on us," he said.

Last year's outbreak, discovery marked the first time in 50 years the disease had threatened Florida's \$1.3-billion citrus industry.

The two most recent outbreaks of canker — at Bill Adams' nursery in Haines City and another nursery owned by Franklyn Ward in nearby Highlands County — were the first in several months.

"No canker has been found at a commercial grower so far."
