Long, costly Peel trial will begin second run

JUNEAU — It was Sept. 4, 1982, when people in the village of Craig were told their lives were in jeopardy.

More than five years later, prosecutors armed with mostly circumstantial evidence returned to court today in a second attempt to convict John Kenneth Peel of the crime.

Peel has pleaded innocent to eight counts of murder and one to the investor case. His first trial in Ketchikan Superior Court ended in a mistrial when the jury failed to reach a verdict.
