Herb Thomas in the 4-day-old trial of Bradley Philip Scott. The former Charlotte County resident was arrested in West Palm Beach in 1985 and charged with the murder that occurred in a deserted field off Tule do Lake Road in Fort Charlotte on Oct. 11, 1978.

If evidence of first-degree murder of the victim of what is expected to be a sensational trial, Scott will be sentenced to die in Florida's electric chair or to life imprisonment with a chance for parole for at least 25 years.

Tue's testimony marked the first time any evidence has been offered to show whether Pikuritz was murdered in the field or whether she was killed elsewhere and brought to the scene in an effort to destroy evidence of another crime.
