### SH man arraigned on murder charges

John Ackroyd of Sweet Home was arraigned in Madras Monday for the killing of a Eugene woman near Camp Sherman.

Ackroyd, 41, appeared before Jefferson County Circuit Judge Gary L. Thompson but did not enter a plea. Thompson ordered the arraignment with this admission to give Ackroyd time to hire a lawyer.

Ackroyd was arrested Friday by Lane County Sheriff's Office on Jefferson County grand jury indictments for a grand murder and murder in connection with the 1971 disappearance of Kaye Jane Turner of Eugene.

Turner had been staying at Camp Sherman for the Christmas holiday when she disappeared on the morning of Dec. 24, 1971. Ackroyd, who worked in the state highway system, had maintenance company at the Sultan Junction, was one of last people reported seeing Turner alive. He is also her paternal cousin, one brother later.

Ackroyd and another man, Roger Dale Beck, 42, of Portland, Ore., were held on the same
